22. SCRUTINY - SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS:  
 Competing vehicles shall be compliant with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual. CAMS approved apparel, including helmets where applicable, must comply with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual and fire extinguisher to the current NCR (Schedule H). Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Cars must be adequately muffled.  
 A valid CAMS-affiliated Club Membership Card and a valid Level 2NS/2NSJ Licence or superior and a Log Book (if issued) must be presented at Document check.

  - Class H Production 4WD ATV (All Terrain Vehicles e.g. Polaris, Kawasaki & Yamaha)
  - Class MP Modified 4wd & 2wd Production Cars
  - Category J Juniors
  - Category L Ladies
  - Non production 4WS (4 Wheel Steering) and 4wd vehicles are not permitted.
  - The use of tyres marked 'not for highway use', 'rally use only', 'mud and snow', or similar are permitted in all classes.
24. **RESULTS, PRIZES & TROPHIES:**  
 Starting and Finishing procedures, Timing, Results and Penalties shall be in accordance with the Khanacross Regulations.
- TROPHIES:** **1<sup>st</sup> Outright,**  
**1<sup>st</sup> in Class where more than 3 in class**  
**1<sup>st</sup> Junior where more than 3 in category**  
**1<sup>st</sup> Lady where more than 3 in category**
25. The CAMS permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
26. The organisers may refuse any entry without assigning a reason in accordance with NCR 83 Of the current CAMS manual
27. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt.
28. Entries from competitors under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to parent/guardian.  
 Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au).
29. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.
30. Protests, if any, must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS manual.
31. **ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES**  
 Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of

alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

**Once you have entered Hampton grounds you are required to head straight to the pit area and stay there, you ARE NOT permitted to leave that area unless you have permission from the clerk of course.**
